#### Audience **Present**

#### FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Call to Order

Ms. Brandon called the meeting to order and read the roll call.

#### SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS **Audience Comments on Agenda Items**

The Board heard from audience members regarding the following: Gardenia Glenn CDD assessment fees, five LED caster lights out by the crepe myrtles, comment on speed limit and speeders on Pleasant Plains Parkway, authorization request to build and place a free little library at the Storybrook Park and District Counsel recommends putting a license agreement in place to protect the District from potential liability.

On a motion from Mr. Daniel Novak, seconded by Mr. Fredrick Lise, the Board approved the District entering into a license agreement with the resident for the purpose of installing a free little library in a mutually agreed on location, on CDD property for the Connerton West Community Development District.

#### THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Resumes for Open Board Seat

The Board discussed the resumes received by candidates for the open Seat #3 and requested that the three residents who were present give a brief introduction and overview of their experience. Mr. Greg Cox explained to the Board that Seat #2 will become vacant in January if Mr. Paul Dorzweiler chooses to not take the Oath of Office and be sworn in. The Board unanimously voted to appoint Mr. Christopher Kawalec to Seat #3 for term 2018-2022.

On a motion from Mr. Knowles, seconded by Mr. Lise, the Board approved to appoint Mr. Kawalec to vacant Seat #3 for the Connerton West Community Development District.

#### FORTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Resolution 2021-02, Appointing Board Member for Open Seat

During the Consideration of Resolution 2021-02, Appointing Board Members for Open Seats, Mr. Cox gave the Oath of Office to Mr. Kawalec and District Counsel discussed the Florida Sunshine Laws. Mr. Kawalec acknowledged that he would receive compensation.
